Strike action is being taken by members of Unison on Wednesday 23rd and Thursday 24th of November.

As you may be aware our Teaching Assistants are greatly integrated into all aspects of school life and cover many crucial roles within school. Due to the number of staff members taking part in the industrial action we would be unable to provide the statutory supervision ratios, first aid cover and classroom support, Teaching Cover and external provision necessary to ensure the welfare of the children both within the school and at break times. As a result. in consultation with the Chair of Governors, the decision has been made that the school will be closed to all pupils on these days for the health and safety of the children.

We appreciate that closing the school will cause inconvenience for families and it is not a decision that we have taken lightly.

New Text Service

We are introducing a new service - 'School Gateway'. This means that you will be able to communicate via the School Gateway smartphone app or website.

It's quick and easy to activate your School Gateway account. All you need are your email address or mobile number that school holds on record for you. If you have a smartphone, please download School Gateway free from your app store (Android and iPhone). The app shows the same information as the website PLUS it saves the school money when we send you a text message and you will be able to message us through the app rather than using your text messaging allowance. You can also use the website www.schoolgateway.com and click on 'New User'. You'll receive a text message with a PIN number. Use this PIN to log into School Gateway. We have sent out a new contact pack and would ask you to complete this and return it school as soon as possible. Please include an email address if you have one.
