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End of Year Message

Dear Parent / carer,

It has been another challenging year for everyone in the world of education but a hugely successful year also due in no small part to the work you do in supporting our school.

Leadgate Primary School standards, across all aspects, continues to improve. Early Years outcomes, for the first time are now equal to national average which is a remarkable achievement increasing from 43% expected standard to 70% expected standard this year. My thanks goes to all the Early Years staff in their continued efforts and achievements. Our Keystage 1 results remain above National and my thanks to all the Keystage1 staff who continue to provide the best education to our pupils. Our Keystage 2 results show continued improvement this year with 100% reaching the expected stand in Reading, 26% Greater depth, 95% expected in writing with 21% greater depth, 95% reaching expected in Grammar, spelling and punctuation with 42% at greater depth, 100% achieving expected standard in Maths and 21% at greater depth. Once again my thanks to all the Keystage2 staff who continue to provide the best education to our pupils.

As the year draws to an end I would personally like to thank you all for your commitment, support, understanding and continuing to work with us in the interests of all our children over the year. It never ceases to impress me how dedicated all the school staff are here in Leadgate Primary and how much the children rise up to the challenges and opportunities they are presented with. I fully appreciate how demanding and exhausting that endeavour is, and I hope you join me in thanking them and the children in making this year such a success.
