

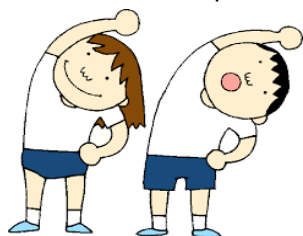
# Leadgate Primary Lower School Newsletter

## IMPORTANT Collecting children from school & clubs

For safeguarding reasons we would like to request that parents do not shout for their child when waiting to collect them at home time. Staff need to identify that a parent or elected adult is waiting to collect a particular child and only then, will they call for that child, and hand them over to the safe care of the parent/adult. Members of staff need to be certain that it is ONLY a child's parent or appointed adult who is collecting them, and would ask for your co-operation with this. Ultimately it is the safety of your children that is of paramount importance
