Due to the size of the dinner hall numbers are limited to 25 and are on a first come first serve basis.

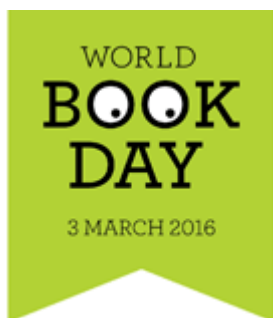
### Reading Club
