## **Attendance and Punctuality**

We understand that children, especially young children, can pick up bugs easily. However, if children have minor illnesses such as colds or cough's please send them into school, and if they continue to feel unwell a member of staff will contact you. The Government set clear targets for attendance and we regularly monitor pupil attendance. We will inform parents of those children whose attendance falls below the Government's threshold, in the hope that with your support, your child's attendance will improve.

We have also noticed that punctuality at the moment is not good and children are regularly arriving at school after the doors close. Again we would like to ask for your help and support in getting children to school on time. They are missing out on vital instructions on what needs to be done, and their education suffers.

### **Packed lunches**

We have noticed that the contents of some of the children's packed lunch boxes are becoming increasingly unhealthy. Please remember they must **NOT** contain fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolate bars including chocolate spread sandwiches. They are not permitted in school and will be sent back home in lunchboxes. No nut products are permitted in school due to allergies. We have also noticed that some children are bringing excessive amounts of food in their packed lunches please make sure portion sizes are appropriate all children have fruit at morning break.

I would also like to ask parents if they could ensure that their child brings a spoon from home if they have a yoghurt in their packed lunch. When children bring fruit, such as grapes, cherries, or plums etc, then stones need to be removed, and the fruit needs to be cut in half, lengthwise.



## **Staffing Changes**

We regret to announce that from this half term Mr Robert Barnes will be leaving us. We would like to take this opportunity to thank Robert for his outstanding commitment to the setting up and development of the Primary schools new Early Years Centre alongside the early Years Team. In his time here Robert has become a valued member of the school and forged great relationships with the pupils in his care.
