## Water Safety and Cold Water Shock

Jumping into rivers without acclimatising can be very dangerous.

Being suddenly immersed in cold water can cause a heart attack. The change in temperature can also lead to a gasp response where you could breathe in water, get into a panic and drown.

Drowning is one of the major causes of adolescent deaths worldwide. An estimated 57,000 ten to nineteen-year-olds drowned across the globe in 2015 – two thirds of them boys.

Do your children know about the dangers of jumping into rivers? Please learn about cold water shock and have the conversation with your children about the dangers of jumping into rivers.
