

School meals - Year 2 & Nursery Parents

<u>Year 2 Parents</u> - Please note that as your child moves from Key Stage 1 into Key Stage 2, at the Upper School, they will no longer qualify for the universal free school meal scheme. Therefore, from September, unless parents are entitled to free meals in their own right, any school meals taken will have to be paid for at a cost of £2 per day.

The increased cost of £2 per day also applies to Nursery Parents who have to pay for their child's meals. If you think that you are entitled to free meals a simple check by County can confirm this, please let us know if this is the case.
