Influenza vaccination in primary school children in years 1, 2 and 3

All children in England in school years 1, 2 and 3 are now eligible for seasonal flu vaccination this autumn via a school based programme.

The provider service for our local authority is Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust (HDFT).

The vaccine itself is called Fluenz Tetra[®] and is given as a nasal spray. This vaccine does not involve an injection. The advantages of this vaccine over the traditional injected flu vaccine are that it is more effective in children and more acceptable to them. HDFT will shortly provide comprehensive information to all parents/guardians and obtain written consent.

Parents will not be required to be present at the vaccination session, but parents can request to attend.
