Lower school = includes all of Nursery, Reception and Years 1 and 2 (West Street Site)

Upper School = includes all of Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 (Alder Grove Site) Early Years = only Nursery and Reception

Keystage 1 = only Years 1 and 2 Keystage 2 = only Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

Any other event specific to a class will be address / labelled by the class year group.
