What the child said – using the child's words.

Note the context, time & date on your record and sign it. Avoid judgements and opinions.

Seek advice as to what to do next from the designated officers ASAP. (Details on back) Be professional. Do not discuss the matter with anyone else. Even if it has already be reported pass it on.

People visiting / working in schools are uniquely placed to notice signs and symptoms of abuse, and to support children subject to and living in abusive situations. A child may want to tell you about what is happening to him or her. Another person may express concerns about a child's wellbeing. You may have noticed significant changes in the way the child performs in school. You may have concerns over appearance of a learner. If you have concerns about a member of staff, please contact the Head Teacher.	 What to do: Listen non – judgementally. Ask open questions to clarify but do not investigate. Do not promise confidentiality, explain you will have to pass information on. Reassure the child but avoid unnecessary physical contact
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
