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Staffing Changes

With the approach of the new academic year comes the opportunity to reorganise and restructure the school. In light of the vacancies generated by staff leaving, the personnel committee and myself, have made the decision to address the issues raised in our latest Ofsted report and continue to build on the numerous strengths already identified by taking immediate action to build capacity within the staffing team and disseminate the strengths we already have.

Therefore, we have appointed two new staff to join us in September. Firstly, Mrs Lauren Bowe will take over as our new Nursery teacher. Mrs Bowe is an Early Years specialist and former EYFS lead who will work with Mrs Nesom, our EYFS leader, to build upon the many strong areas identified by inspectors.

Mrs Reed is reducing her days next year to 4 days a week and will therefore come out of class to cover senior leaders and SENCO Management time allowing us to make optimum use of her musical skills and talent, raising the profile of music within school, with children that she will know well from teaching in both Reception and Nursery.

Mr Todd will be moving to take Year 4 in Upper School. Our second new teacher, Mrs Melissa Pedro, will become our new full time Year 1 teacher. Mrs Pedro will be known to many parents from the time she covered teaching in Nursery over this last year before leaving on Maternity Leave. These changes will allow us to create capacity within the school for leaders and teachers to undertake the many roles they perform, use the strengths of specialist teachers in more than one age group.

Both new staff will be in school this term as part of our transition so the children will have an opportunity to meet their new class teacher, and work with them, before entering their new class in September. Parents and carers will also have an opportunity to meet both new staff at parent/carer meetings.

I hope you will join me in welcoming both new staff to the school and look forward to them working with our children.
