#### **Parent Consultation - Diary Events**

Following consultation on events and the impact on families being able to attend diary events we have collated the information you have shared and tried to make changes that suit more families. Therefore, we will be running all class assemblies, one a day, at 9.10, moving all Easter and Christmas Assemblies to 9.30. Harvest festival will no longer be an open service but held in school for children only. The Christmas fayre will be held on Upper school site only and the summer fayre will be an open afternoon with both Sites holding different aspects of the fayre in respect to the different ages of children on site. The start time will be staggered on the same afternoon and parents / carers can sign children out to attend across both sites all within 1 afternoon.
