Community Garden at Blackhill & Consett Park

A new season of gardening activities in the Community Garden at Blackhill & Consett Park is starting on Monday 18th March. The sessions run between 1pm and 3pm, and meet at 1pm in the classroom on the ground floor of The Lodge, which is located near to the main entrance into the park on Laburnum Avenue, Blackhill. As most of the session will be outdoors in the community garden, please dress appropriately.
