
### ...... **Mental Health Activity**

#### HOUSEHOLD SUPPORT GRANT VOUCHERS

The county have notified the school that further assistance in the form of the Government's Household Support Grant will be available this Spring term.

Vouchers will be sent for families eligible for Free School Meals through school once again. The vouchers are not to cover free school meals during holiday periods, but are there to help families with the costs of fuel and food through the winter.

It is planned that vouchers will be sent out to schools in the weeks beginning the 28th February and 8th March 2022.
