


School Dates

School reopens Wednesday 6th
September at normal time.
School will close at the end of the day
on Friday 27th October for half term
and reopen Monday morning, 6th
November.

School will then close at the end of the day Tuesday 19th December for the Christmas Holidays.



Medication

Please remember that if your child requires medication a medication administration form must be completed by an adult with parental responsibility. These can be requested from the school office.

Unless there is a specific administration time children requiring 3 doses of medication will only need 1 administered during school time the others being given at home.

If possible please ask the dispensing chemist / doctor for a split prescription so that medication can remain in school and at home other wise please ensure staff are notified that medication must be returned each day.

Breakfast with a Book

Breakfast with a book will resume on Lower school site for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children at 8.30 each morning starting Monday 11th September.

Children should be brought to main reception door each morning.



PE days

Teachers will message all parents their class PE days on class dojo by the end of the first week.

Please remember that all jewellery - including ear rings - must be removed before participation.

Arbor

From September we will be using a new parent text service called Arbor and further information will follow. The App will also allow parents to live update all their contact details. Look out for news next week

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club will continue to run on both school sites starting on Wednesday 6th September at 8am.

The cost will increase to £2.00 per day per child.

Children should be brought to the main entrance on lower school site and delivered to staff. On Upper school site children can access breakfast club through the Main reception Entrance door.

Dinners

Dinners resume on Wednesday. The new daily cost for dinners from 6th September is £2.50. This cost applies to all non free school meals in keystage 2 and all Nursery children.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 remain free under Universal free school meals.

Works over Summer

Work has continued over the summer holiday and at the Lower School site children will now be using their new classrooms - with Year 1 moving into the former Happy Smiles Class – this will also allow them to access continuous provision with outdoor access from the classroom available as they now progress on from the Reception class.

New Classes after Summer

Further work has continued over the summer holiday to rearrange and prepare rooms across the whole school and both Upper and Lower school will now see classes moved around in preparation for opening new intervention spaces in the old Year 5 class and old Year 2 Classroom. Children should already be familiar with this arrangement as transition days were held in the new rooms before the Summer holiday

Nursery & Reception Classes continue to be dropped off and collected from the Nursery Play Yard doors. Year 1 will now be dropped off and collected from their new location in the old Happy Smiles Building. Year 2 will continue to drop off and collect from the usual door as you enter the lower school play yard. Year 3 will now be in the old ICT room at the front of the school and accessed off the main year as will the Year 4 class.

Year 5 and Year 6 will now enter their classes where year 3 & 4 use to be from the yard facing onto the school field.
