

Personal, social and emotional development

- Learning routines and expectations of school, adapting and becoming familiar with the school environment
- Sharing feelings using 'Zones of Regulation' to express emotions
- Making new friends and learning about others
- Taking turns and sharing
- Learning about new feelings and ways to manage our own emotions

Communication and Language



- Developing listening skills, paying attention to stories and teacher inputs
- Learning new vocabulary and reinforcing words we know
- Singing nursery rhymes and playing with words/sounds
- Storytelling and sequencing stories. Sharing what we remember
- Action songs
- Role play linked to familiar books

Mathematics

- Securing counting 1:1 accurately to 10
- Recognising numerals and matching quantities to numerals
- Sorting items by size, length and weight
- Learning names of 2d shapes, square, circle, rectangle, oval and hexagon
- Singing number songs and rhymes
- Counting one more/one less

Literacy

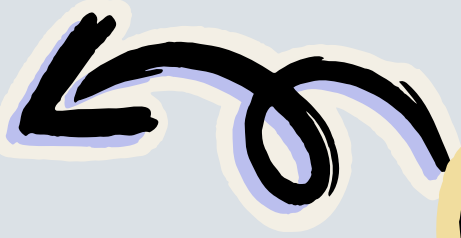


- Recognising and writing own name
- Identifying logos and symbols, recognising familiar words such as Mummy/Daddy
- Hear and first sounds in words
- Clap out syllables in words and our names
- Little Wandle Phonics Scheme learning letter sounds and developing reading skills
- Form some recognisable letters

Physical Development

- Taking care of our bodies
- Developing awareness of body position and awareness of others
- Dressing and undressing
- Improving large movements, running, jumping etc
- Developing pencil grip and control of mark making materials
- Dough disco

- Building and joining materials using different methods
- Family pictures and taking photos
- Outdoor art, large movements using paints and sweeping brushes
