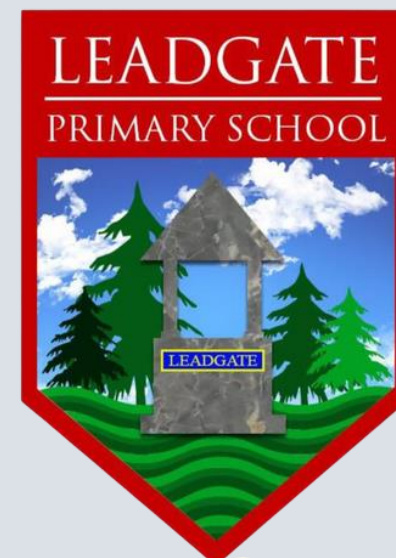
English

Children will develop reading, phonics, spelling, grammar, and handwriting. They will build vocabulary, comprehension, and writing skills, progressing to stories, reports, poetry, and confident speaking and listening across different contexts.



Maths

Children will build skills in number, calculation, place value, fractions, measurement, geometry, and data handling. They will develop problem-solving and reasoning. Learning will be adapted using practical resources, visual support, scaffolding, and small steps to meet individual needs.

Trips

Children will take part in trips to care for animals, explore the local area, and experience different types of transport. These visits will develop responsibility, confidence, social skills, real-world understanding, and curiosity about their community.



Forest School

Children will take part in Forest School sessions, learning outdoor skills such as building shelters, using tools safely, fire-lighting, exploring nature, teamwork, problem-solving, and developing confidence, resilience, and a love of the natural environment.
