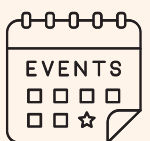

Children arriving before 8:45am must either:

- Be supervised by a parent or carer, or
- Attend our Breakfast Club, which is free from 8:30am and provides a safe, welcoming start to the day.

Reception & Secondary School Admissions – September 2026

If your child is due to start Reception or Secondary School in September 2026, please be aware of the following important dates and application details:

Apply Now

Reception Admissions (Sept 2026)

- For children born between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022
- Applications open: Autumn 2025
- Deadline to apply: 15th January 2026

Secondary School Admissions (Sept 2026)

- Applications open: 1st September 2025
- Deadline to apply: 31st October 2025

All applications must be made through Durham County Council. Please ensure you apply within the given timeframe to secure your child's place.



Nursery Places Available – Apply Now!

We currently have spaces available in our Nursery for children aged three and above. Children become eligible for 15 hours of funded provision starting from the term after their third birthday. We typically welcome new starters in September, January, and after Easter, but please note that places are limited, so we encourage early registration to secure your child's space.

Attending our nursery provides numerous benefits, including enhanced social skills, early learning experiences, and a strong foundation for future education. 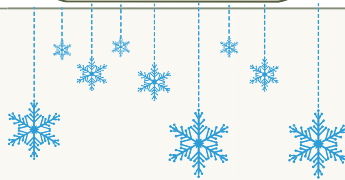
